Leadership, adaptability, problem-solving skills, and a strong understanding of efficient production & work processes are essential for success in this role. A successful Customer Fabrication & Manufacturing Manager combines technical expertise with leadership skills, has a strategic mindset and can drive operational excellence.

Key Responsibilities

- Coordinate daily with Custom Fabrication Sales Team Lead/Shop Team Lead and other Sales Team Members engaging in Custom Fab Projects to schedule projects/orders through the shop.
- Receive and manage MO's (Manufacturing Orders) from CF Sales Lead.
- Create, manage, and close Manufacturing Orders (MOs) for other selected Sales Team Members engaged in Custom Fabrication Projects.
- Ensure MOs are complete and accurate prior to proceeding to production.
- Production Planning and Scheduling.
- Provide drawing and design support (SolidWorks) for Custom Fabrication & Mfg. Division.
- Manage shop inventory (all supplies, components, and manufactured assemblies) placing purchase requests as required.
- Find the most efficient way to handle purchasing for projects once MOs are created.
- Implement Quality Control systems and work procedures for projects going through the shop.
- Manage the Fabrication team, providing ongoing mentorship, skills training and fully participate in the performance management of direct reports.
- Create a "Safety First" culture through leading by example and correcting unsafe practices. Take on a leadership role within the Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee.
- Estimate shop labour, materials, and components costs to assist Sales Team in quoting and selling projects.
- Develop expertise in products, materials, applications, and technical service abilities through self-learning and hands-on experience with customer projects alongside other senior team members.
- Maintain accurate project and customer information within the MO & ERP system.
- Update estimating tools, making more comprehensive and easily understood.
- Document company's known Design & Engineering standards for constructing products and update as new projects come through the shop.
- Monitor and make improvements with shop throughput.

- Enhance the Project/MO Document package to include all key items, QC milestones, and hand-offs (e.g., Sales to Shop, Shop to Shipping), along with Testing Records, Packaging and Shipping Instructions, and Safety and Quality Procedures.
- Maintain vendor relationships as needed.
- Work closely with company Financial Controller to optimize systems and procedures.

Skills and Qualifications

- Minimum of 3 5 years in a leadership role for Production Coordination and Management in a Custom Fabrication and Manufacturing environment with a proven track record.
- Post-secondary education required, preferably a diploma in a technical discipline i.e., Mechanical or Manufacturing Technologist.
- 2D/3D AutoCAD/Solid Works knowledge and proficiency is required.
- Mechanical aptitude, with the ability to read and understand drawings and have technical discussions with contractors and engineers.
- Proven organizational skills and efficient use of technology tools.
- Exceptional customer service skills with an interest in building business relationships.
- Excellent active listening, communication, and interpersonal skills with the ability to communicate clearly and effectively over the phone or in person.
- Must be fully fluent in English both verbally and in writing.
- Candidate must be able to work in a team environment as well as work independently.
- Strong problem-solving ability.
- Labour/Equipment/Materials estimating ability required.
- Strong understanding of manufacturing processes and techniques relevant to the industry (i.e.: machining, assembly, fabrication).
- General knowledge of Mechanical systems or liquid and materials handling considered an asset.
