The Northwest Coast Archaeological Permit Holder will join Katzie Development Limited Partnership (KDLP) and report to the Operations Manager. This position will work out of the Langley office and in the field as required. Applicants who qualify to hold HCA permits but have not achieved full permit holder status are encouraged to apply.

### Key Responsibilities

- Mentoring Archaeological Staff, as appropriate;
- Preparing or contributing to proposals;
- Securing heritage inspection, investigation, and alteration permits;
- Designing and leading archaeological field programs;
- Liaising with First Nations and community members;
- Managing project scope, schedule, and cost;
- Participating in business development activities, including meetings with prospective clients;
- Participating in Indigenous community relationship-building activities;
- Undertaking analysis and preparing technical reports;
- Writing permit applications, interim reports, and final reports;
- Assisting with operations, as required.

- Possess a BA and or BSc with an archaeology major (a master's degree is desirable);
- Must be an Associate or Professional member of the British Columbia Association of Professional Archaeologists (BCAPA);
- Minimum 6 years experience in Cultural Resource Management;
- Minimum 6 years experience identifying and recording traditional use sites & features, CMTs, and a full range of coastal archaeological site types;
- A valid class 5 driver's license and clean driver's abstract;
- Desire to work closely (in both leadership and supporting roles) with First Nations;
- Excellent writing and communication skills including experience with technical report writing;
- Able to work independently as well as a part of a team.
