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

Industry Outlook - 2024 Trade – China (Canola)

- China said there was a relationship between the rise in imports of canola by Canada and the drop in the domestic price
- Covers period from Jan 1 Dec 31, 2023
- Canada has until early November to respond with preliminary data to support its position that there was no dumping.





Industry Outlook - 2024 Trade – China (Canola)

- More than half of Canada's canola exports land up in China while almost all that China imports comes from Canada (94%)
- Largely seen as retaliatory based on Canadian tariffs on EV vehicles and Steel/Aluminum from China
- China also involved in trade disputes with EU dairy and EU pork






Industry Outlook - 2024 Canada – India Conflict

- Both Canada and India have expelled each others diplomats out of their respective countries
- Canada indicates they have evidence of Indian involvement in crimes against Canadians within Canada
 - Concerns for impact on (ag) trade with India as 77% of lentil imports comes from Canada
- Other significant exports:
 - Crude rapeseed or canola oil
 - Dry beans
 - Coal
 - Potash fertilizer
 - Newsprint paper



Crops

- 2024 Harvest Outlook
- Farm Equipment
- Farmland Values

- Equipment ratio on grain farms is important.
- Ensure all property of creditor included on debt security
- Verify proper registration on land and related farm equipment
- Verify crop insurance & AgriStability status





Corn

The 2024 USDA forecast from October are the following:

- Harvest expected at 15.2 billion bu
- Average expected yield of 183.8 bushels/acre which is up from 177.3 bushels/acre in 2023
- USD\$4.10/bushel season expected price in 2024/2025

Soybeans

The 2024 USDA forecast from February are the following:

- Harvest expected at 4.6 billion bu
- Average expected yield of 53.1 bushels/acre which is up from 50.6 bushels/acre in 2023
- USD\$10.80/bushel season expected price in 2024/2025







Grain Production - Canada

Soybeans

- 5.7 million expected harvested acres in 2024
- 5.6 million harvested acres in 2023
- Estimated yield of 46.4 bushels/acre which is up from 45.9 bushels/acre in 2023

Canola

- 21.7 million expected harvested acres for 2024
- 21.9 million harvested acres in 2023
- Estimated yield of 38.5 bushels/acre which is up from 36.9 bushels/acre in 2023

Wheat (excl. Durum)

- 19.8 million expected harvested acres for 2024
- 20.5 million harvested acres in 2023
- Estimated yield of 52.3 bushels/acre which is up from 49.9 bushels/acre in 2023







Machinery purchases slowing

- 2WD farm tractors down 25.3% YOY
- 4WD farm tractors up 13.6% YOY
- Combine sales down 51.9% YOY Source: Association of Equipment Manufacturers




Hogs

- Outlook for improved margins on lower feed costs
- Weak demand from key importing countries leading to softer price outlook
- Demand

- Perform walk-through on short notice and assess condition of herd and barn operations
- Verify proper registration on land and related farm equipment
- Verify AgriStability status.


Cattle

- Continued strong outlook for overall sector moving forward
- Lower inventories in industry
- Feedlot margins improving due to lower feed grains

- Perform walk-through on short notice
- Verify inventory and require manifests and/or proof of purchase or sale. Look closely at inventory values.
- Verify AgriStability and risk management practices.



- Canadian cow and heifer for beef replacement at its lowest since 1987
- COOL could impact Canadian pricing if US processors feel they can take advantage of the opportunity (Jan 2026)

Wineries

- Frost in BC interior has result in major expected losses in tree fruit/grape
 - Reduced tariffs on grapes brought in from outside the province
- BC has \$70-million replanting program after devastating crop loss
- Sales coming off of pandemic high levels

- *Verify Inventory (and value in-use).- sample to ensure quality.*
- Confirm terms of licences to produce and sell are being met.
- Seek rolling 5 year plans/third-party input primary downfall is cash and inventory management.






Cannabis

- Usage declining YOY.
- Industry reaching state of maturity

- Ensure all property of creditor included on debt security.
- Confirm terms of licences to produce and sell are being met.
- Confirm key individuals named in licences are tied to the company.





Self-reported use of cannabis in Canada






Food and Beverage
